Q:

Why is it
important to
be humble?

A:

Humility acknowledges our dependence on God and allows us to serve others with a Christ-like attitude.

Philippians 2:3-4 - "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others."

Q:

How can we
handle peer
pressure?

A:

We can resist peer pressure by standing firm in our faith and making choices that align with God's Word.

Romans 12:2 - "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will."

A:

God's peace comes from
trusting Him and
surrendering our worries
to Him in prayer.

Philippians 4:7 - "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

communicate with God
and build a relationship
with Him.

Philippians 4:6-7 - "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God."

surrendering our lives to
Him, obeying His
teachings, and seeking to
become more like Him.**

**Matthew 16:24 - "Then Jesus said to his
disciples, 'Whoever wants to be my disciple
must deny themselves and take up their cross
and follow me.'"**

A:

We can be a light by living out our faith, showing kindness, and sharing the hope we have in Christ.

Matthew 5:16 - "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."

and serve God,
bringing glory to Him
in all that we do.

1 Corinthians 10:31 - "So whether you eat or
drink or whatever you do, do it all for the

1 John 4:18 - "There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love."

harmonious family.**

**Ephesians 6:1 - "Children, obey your parents in
the Lord, for this is right."**

We can maintain a thankful heart by recognizing and appreciating the blessings God has given us.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 - "Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

A:

Baptism is a public declaration of faith, symbolizing the death and resurrection of Jesus and our new life in Him.

Romans 6:4 - "We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life."

John 14:26 - "But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you."

1 Corinthians 10:13 - "No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear."

Jesus came to save us
from our sins and
show us the way to
eternal life.

John 3:16 - "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

1 John 4:7 - "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God."
